

Rules for Exhibitors

1. This exhibit is open to all artists 18 years of age or older, who produce 2-D and / or 3-D, nature related art (i.e. wildlife, landscapes, floral, etc.)
2. All works shown and sold must be of original concept, design and execution. Works made with the use of commercial kits, molds or patterns will not be accepted. Spring's Wings seeks to maintain the highest standards for both exhibitor and the viewing public.
3. Only signed and numbered prints pulled directly from the original plate may be shown. Digital art must be printed on archival quality materials, signed and numbered in limited editions. Photographs must be signed, numbered and developed by the artist or by a person strictly supervised by the artist.
4. Exhibitor fee of \$50 (separate check) will be returned if applicant is not selected (fee is deposited after the jurying is completed). Exhibitor fees may be refunded until April 1, 2008 if the space can be filled. Exhibitor fee is not refundable after April 24, 2008.
5. Submit, by mail or email, three (3) slides or photographs that are representative of your current work. Only cardboard or plastic mounted slides are acceptable. Each slide must be labeled: applicant's name, media, size of work, title of work and top of work. Spring's Wings reserves the right to use submitted entries for publicity. Entries will be returned to artists during the Art Festival. Unselected entries will be returned if a self-addressed envelope with correct postage is included with entry.
6. The artist responsible for creating the work on display in the booth must be in attendance during the show.
7. Exhibit space will be under a large tent or under the artist's own individual tent. An 8' table will be provided for 3-D artists and a 10' x 10' booth space will be provided for 2-D artists.
8. Spring's Wings will provide an exhibit area for each participant and security during the day; however, each exhibitor displays and sells all work at his/her own risk. Spring's Wings is not responsible for damage, theft or loss of an individual's work. Furthermore, Spring's Wings is responsible for all promotion, publicity and advertising.
9. Exhibitors are responsible for all props and exhibition materials. Work must be shown during all Art Festival hours; which are Set up: Saturday, 6am to 9am; Exhibit and competition, Saturday, 9am to 6pm.
10. The earliest post-marked requests for electric hook-up will be given preference on a first come, first served basis.
