## *About the Program*

The Woodland Building is an educational exhibit featuring native Wisconsin wildlife in their woodland habitats.

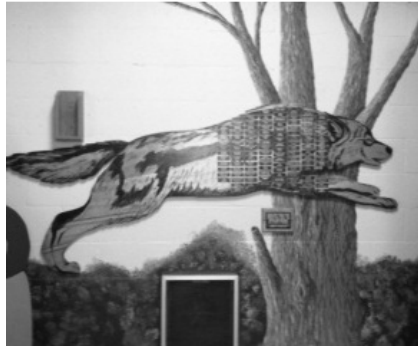
Exhibit animals are selected to tell stories about wildlife:

- Predators and prey
- Adaptations for survival
- Nocturnal life style
- Endangered species
- Conservation

Most animals are obtained through the Sanctuary's rehabilitation program.

## *Did You Know?*

- Wolves can reach 4.5-6.5 feet long (including 15-19 inch tail) and 2.5 feet high.
- Wolves weigh 50-85 pounds
- Top speed for wolves is about 25 miles an hour and can keep up a running pace all night.
- Wolves are social animals, living in a pack. A pack usually has six to ten animals including a dominant male and female, pups from the previous year and the current year's pups.
- Each wolf requires approximately 10 square miles to hunt and socialize.



## *How it Works*
