HALF-DAY CAMPS:

ARTY ADVENTURES: Drawing, painting, plant press and more! We will create different nature themed art to take home.

FURS, FINS, FEATHERS: We will introduce your child to coverings and camouflage! They will learn why/how animals, insects and even plants are colored and covered the way they are. We will do different activities, projects, and crafts that highlight and help teach young kids about the natural wonderful wild world.

LITTLE EXPLORERS: Introduce your young child to the sights, sounds and textures of the outdoor world. Every day is a different adventure! We'll explore trails, ponds and the forest!

NATURE NUTS: We'll help make your child nuts about nature! Each day will start with a different theme and will include activities like hiking, fishing, birdwatching, discovering pond life, crafts and a scavenger hunt.

YOUNG CITIZEN SCIENTISTS: Citizen scientists contribute to actual research! Your child will learn to study wildlife and the natural world with a more scientific approach and real data collection!

ALL ABOUT ANIMALS: This camp will be all about animals. We will explore many areas of the Wildlife Sanctuary, including the rehabilitation facility. Activities will include a pond study, nature hiking, bird and insect identification and animal track studies.
